- P 81: Course description for BIO 270 Microbiology was updated to: This course provides an overview of the biology of microorganisms. Subjects taught will include the anatomy, physiology, taxonomy, genetics, medical significance, and responses of the human body to bacteria, viruses, fungi, and parasitic organisms. The student will learn the application of principles of microbiology in the health care environment, including the identification, control, and prevention of infectious agents.

The course is taught in a systems format, with an appreciation for the intricacies and interdependence of the various systems of the human body, their normal structure and function, and responses of the systems to changes in the external and internal environment.
