

MSN (direct entry) & Accelerated BSN



The MSN (direct entry) and Accelerated BSN programs are designed to accommodate distance education students, with the majority of coursework completed online. One-week clinical residencies occur during the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th semester at the Joyce Johnson Center of Simulation in Draper, Utah.*

RESIDENCY AND CLINICAL REQUIREMENTS

SEMESTER 1

- No residencies or clinical rotations during the first semester.
- Immunizations and CPR must be completed prior to the second semester.

SEMESTER 2

- **45 direct patient care clinical hours**
 - This may occur over a 4-day consecutive block or spread out over the semester. Ameritech's clinical placement team will work with each student to determine their clinical schedule.
 - Generally occurring in the student's state of residence.*
- **Utah residency requirement: 30 hours of lab over a one-week period.**

SEMESTER 3

- **60 direct patient care clinical hours**
 - Five 12-hour shifts. This may occur as 1 day per week for 5 weeks or spread out over the semester.
 - Generally occurring in the student's state of residence.*
- **24 hours of mental health clinical hours**
 - This equates to two 12-hour shifts.
 - Generally occurring in the student's state of residence.*
- **Utah residency requirement: 42 hours over a one-week period.**
 - 24 hours of campus-based simulation (this may be completed in 12 hours depending on format of simulation experiences).
 - 30 lab hours

SEMESTER 4

- **72 direct patient care clinical hours**
 - Generally occurring in the student's state of residence.*
- **Utah residency requirement: 30 hours of simulation over a one-week period.**

SEMESTER 5

- **112.5 hours of direct patient care capstone hours**
 - Generally occurring in the student's state of residence.*
- **No Utah residency requirement.**

*Ameritech College of Healthcare strictly enrolls students in its Master of Science in Nursing – direct entry, and Bachelor of Science in Nursing - Accelerated BSN, distance education prelicensure programs, who are residents of Utah and Colorado. Clinical availability is at the discretion of Ameritech's clinical partners and is subject to change.
