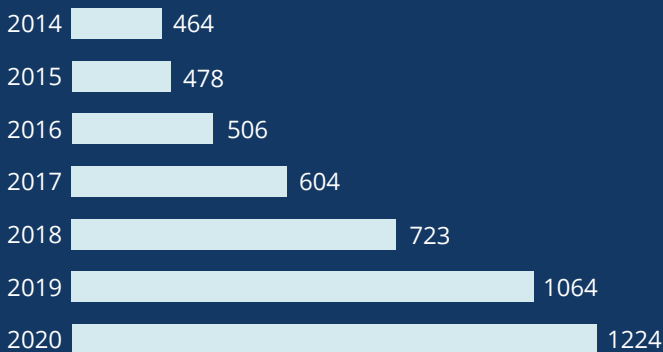
To prepare people to serve as competent professionals, to advance their careers, and to pursue lifelong learning.

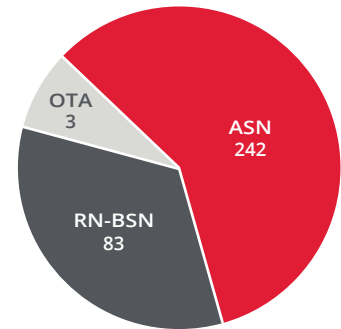

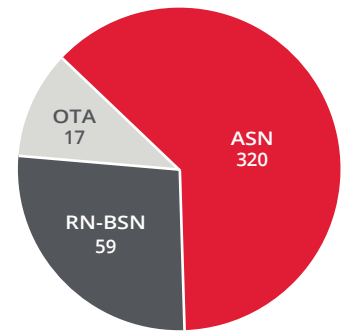

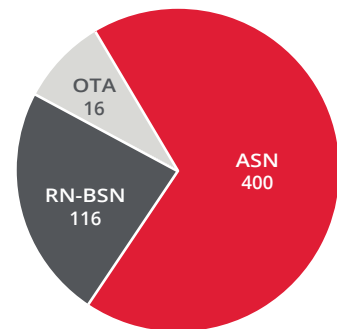
